

## Infrastructure/Maintenance Committee Report - September 17, 2019

- Post Dorian drive through within the SPB neighborhood found very little problems; just the occasional small branches broken. There was some flooding on 2-3 of the streets but nothing that caused a concern. We also walked back to the Troon Ditch and found the water moving without any obstructions.
- The lights to the entrance of SPB have finally been fixed and the timer put on the proper am/pm setting. The gazebo will also undergo some much-needed repair, as well as the cupola.
- A Live Oak tree has been purchased at Hughes and Hughes and will be planted during the last week of September in front of the tennis courts to replace the tree damaged in last year's hurricane.
- Prestige Lighting provided the committee a bid for outdoor lighting in front of the Resident's Center; the bid has been given to the Board for review.
- The repaired lights in the kiddie pool were not functioning yesterday. Removal of the kiddie pool and replacement options for the area are still being considered.
